- 4. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at North Lincolnshire Council, Civic Centre, Ashby Road, Scunthorpe, DN16 1AB by 5pm on Wednesday 8 June 2016.
- New applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at North Lincolnshire Council, Civic Centre, Ashby Road, Scunthorpe, DN16 1AB by 5pm on Wednesday 15 June 2016. Requests for changes to existing proxy vote arrangements and cancellations must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 8 June 2016.
- 6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy on the grounds of disability or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at North Lincolnshire Council, Civic Centre, Ashby Road, Scunthorpe, DN16 1AB by **5pm** on **Thursday 23 June 2016**. The disability must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 15 June 2016. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 15 June 2016.
