	To provide the following Grass Verge Cutting within Amcotts Parish:
	Grass verges are to be cut to a length of 30mm with strimming around obstructions, street
	furniture and arisings blown clear of footways.
	The cuttings are to be in 3 weekly cycles during the cutting season.
	To provide the following Footpath Cutting within Amcotts Parish:
	Footpath 6 is to be cut to a length of 50mm. This should include surface growth, overhanging growth (allowing a height of at least 6.5ft) and growth around signposts, waymark posts and structures, such as bridges, gates and stiles but not hedges (unless these are rooted within the path itself), nor crops or trees, shrubs or other vegetation ostensibly being grown for commercial reasons.
	Footpath 6 is to be cut 3 times per year. Ideally May, late June and late August.
